ORGANIZING AUTHORITY: Jericho Sailing Centre, Vancouver, Hobie Fleet 214, Vancouver

RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, Prescriptions of the National Authority, Applicable Class Rules. Sailing Instructions will be available on-site.

ENTRIES

Open to all catamaran classes. Classes other than Hobie and F18 must pre-register with 5 or more boats by June 15th to obtain a separate start. There will be no handicapped rating starts. HCANA membership is required for crew or skipper of Hobie Classes. This will be a points qualified regatta for Hobie Classes. Proof of Liability Insurance may be required. A link for online registration will be provided on the Jericho website and at hobiediv4.org. Onsite registration will be accepted on the day of the regatta.

SCORING

The low point scoring system in Rule A4 will be used. When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. One race shall be completed to constitute a regatta. HCANA regatta points will be award to all Hobie classes as determined by the Hobie Class Association.

VENUE

Races will be conducted in the waters of English Bay. The Launch location is the Jericho Sailing Centre, 1300 Discovery St. Vancouver, BC

FEES

\$50 for Single handed boats\$65 for Double handed boats1 meal ticket is provided for each sailor. Additional meal tickets for guests may be purchase upon registration.

SCHEDULE

Registration will be Saturday, June 27th, 0900-1000. Competitors meeting will be at 1030h. First Warning Signals: Saturday June 27th, 1200h Sunday June 28th, 1000h No races shall be started after 1500h on Sunday June 28th.

MEASUREMENT: Each boat is expected to comply with class rules for their boat.

COURSES: The courses to be sailed will be standard IHCA courses. These will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

PENALTY SYSTEM: For all classes, rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

PRIZES: Prizes will be awarded based on attendance and as deemed by the Organizing Authority.

RADIO COMMUNICATION: Boats may carry personal radios but, except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

ACCOMMODATIONS

RV's are permitted overnight in the Jericho parking lot. Limited tenting is available in the Jericho compound. Other accommodation is located nearby.
