1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing as well as relevant class rules.

2.0 Eligibility & Entry:

2.1 The regatta is open to class legal Hobie Wave, 14, 16, 17, 18, F18 (Tiger & Wildcat) and 20s. Five entries constitute a one-design class. One sailor on each boat must be a current HCA-NA member.

3.0 Sailing Instructions: Available at registration.

4.0 Venue: Grays Harbor, Washington.

5.0 Insurance: Each participating boat shall have current 3rd party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of not less than \$100,000.
