**Rules**: The regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing as well as relevant class rules. **Eligibility & Entry**: The regatta is open to class legal Hobie Wave, 14, 16, 17, 18, F18 (Tiger & Wildcat) and 20s. Five entries constitute a one design class. One person on each heat must be 2020 HCA NA members.

**Sailing Instructions**: Available at registration.

Venue: Columbia River between Skamokawa Vista Park and Astoria, OR.

**Insurance**: Each participating boat shall have current 3<sup>rd</sup> party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of not

less than \$100,000.

Lodging: Camping is available at Skamokawa Vista Park (for a fee). Skamokawa Inn, a local B&B is also available.
